St. Mary's School Payment/Pickup Agreement 2022-23

Please read the following information carefully, initial each statement and sign at the bottom indicating your agreement to abide by these terms.

_____ I understand that the Aftercare fees need to be paid in a timely manner. Prolonged unpaid fees could result in dismissal from the program. (Please note that there is a one-hour minimum charge for each session your child attends.)

_____ I understand that my child/ren need to be picked up no later than 6pm and that late charges could result from repeated late pick-ups.

_____ I understand that if a medical emergency arises, the program staff will first attempt to contact me. If the emergency is such that immediate hospital attention is necessary, an ambulance or emergency vehicle may take my child to the hospital.

_____ I understand that unless the program staff is notified in writing or the parent notifies the school office via a phone call, no child will be allowed to board a bus, walk home, or otherwise make changes to the known schedule.
