What's Happening in Physical Education Class

Physical Education class takes place on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday for students in 1stthrough 8th grade and Kindergarten on Tuesday and Wednesday. Our goal is that our children develop healthy attitudes that eventually lead to a lifestyle of regular physical activity.

The first nine weeks we have tried to be outside as much as the weather will allow and we have had a great fall. Kindergarten, first and second have spent time learning the rules and being able to move in general space without collisions. We have learned the stop sign and work on locomotor movement. We familiarize ourselves with the gym markings and directions. Many low organized games are played to teach our students body awareness while moving in general space to work on fitness at the same time. Some of their favorite games include Ready Set, Mouse Trap, Bridge Tag, Pizza Tag, Toxic Blast and The Chase. We have also spent time working on our ball skills and soccer skills and mini soccer games. Also, asked your child to take you through our obstacle course we have painted in our alley. Can you perform those skills?

Grades third through eighth started the year reviewing the rules and working For Each Other and Win Today! Class is usually started with a warm up followed by our activity for the day. We started the year with kickball learning the rules which we hope will carry over to softball and baseball playing. We then switched to disc golf. This is the second year for disc golf and the students have improved each time they golf. We have a four hole course we set up throughout the school grounds. We even had our first hole-in-one last week. Not only did Noah Merrill have the first but followed it with a second on the same day. The students have learned about the different disc they can use and the forehand and backhand technique of throwing. In addition, a favorite game we like to play during this time of year is Ghost and the Graveyard.
