Please see the following report:

Education Commission September Committee Reports:

Marketing: Donut Sundays have been going well. There will not be a Donut Sunday in October due to the conflict with the Lourdes parish pancake and sausage breakfast. They will be moving inside as of November and coffee will be available. A basic marketing plan has been created and presented to the Commission for review/comments.

Fundraising and Development: Planning for the 2023 School Auction is underway. The selected theme is Rock and Roll. The Bags for Bucks fundraiser is underway now. There are open needs on the committee currently. Please contact Christen Bergstresser if you would like to volunteer.

Planning and Assessment: Will be working with Principal Kiesewetter on the handbook review. Will be responsible for review of the strategic plan at each meeting with the Commission to assure there is progress toward the plan goals.

Budget and Resources: no past activity this month. A meeting with Father Kipfer will be scheduled to work on a communication plan with the parish Finance Committee.

Facilities: Drawings are being created to obtain cost proposals for replacement of gutters and downspouts, and for a new fall zone for the new swing set. The swing set is due to be shipped in September, but the installation will likely occur in the Spring to coincide with the installation of the fall zone.
