Old Settler's Days - The Meat and Potato Makers

In 2022, we had over \$38,000 in sales in the food tent. That's a lot of food!! About 83% of those sales came from the "meat and potatoes". In the food tent throughout the course of the week, we grill up over 2,700 steakburgers and over 1,000 pork chops. We fry up over 2,100 orders of fries. We offer additional eating options for our guests, including hot dogs, chili dogs, BBQ sandwiches, nachos, cheese cups, chili cups, chili fries, cheese fries and.....well you get the idea. There are a lot of combinations!

In order to prepare the meat and potatoes, we schedule people for 3-4 hour shifts. We will fill roughly 26 steakburger chef spots, 15 pork chop grill master spots, 13 french fryer spots and 20 "nacho corner" spots. Steakburger chefs will work on large flat top grills in the middle of the tent to load up the grills, flip the burgers, add the cheese, place the burgers on a bun and work with the burger wrapper.. Pork chop grill masters work on a grill outside the main tent. These folks are responsible for sending scrumptious smells into the air to attract hungry carnival-goers. The fry chef position is in the thick of the action in the tent and takes very little skill, leaving plenty of time to socialize. The nacho corner multi-tasker is just that, responsible for BBQ, chili, nachos, cheese, hot dogs and all the combinations. This position will keep you on your toes.

Although these positions are the "meat and potatoes" of the event, they only comprise about ¼ to ⅓ of the spots that we need to fill to make the food tent successful. Please save the date for June 21-24 to help with this endeavor. Sign ups for all of the positions will be available the first week of May.
